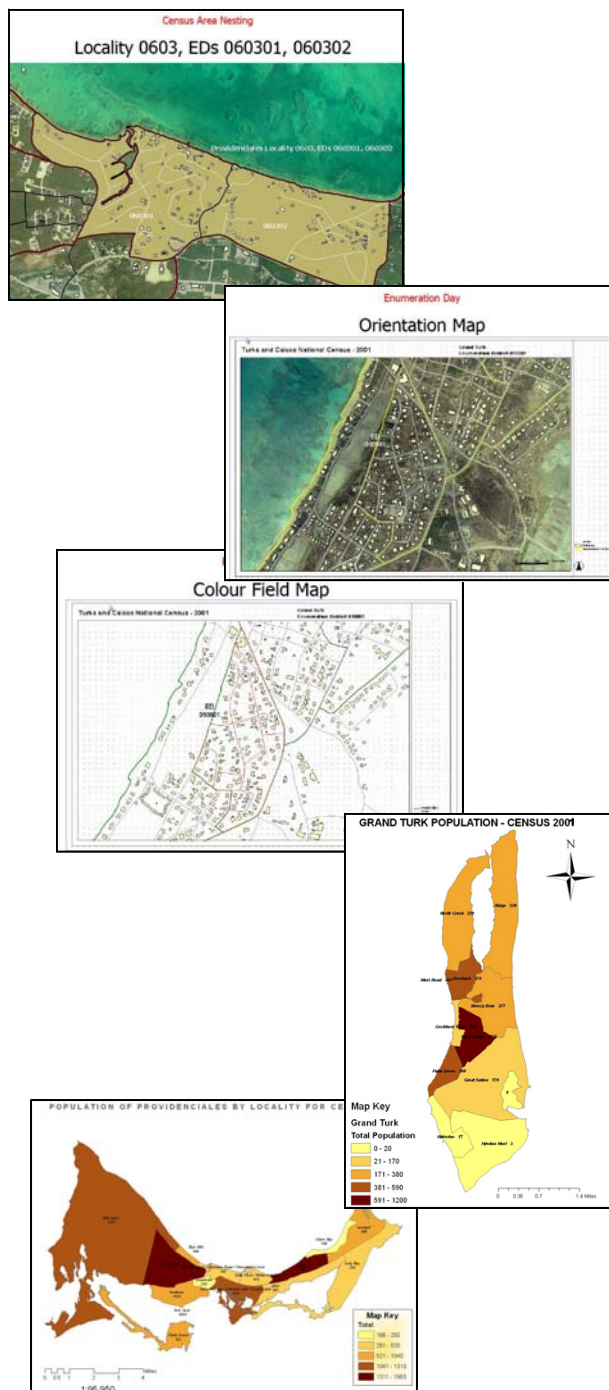
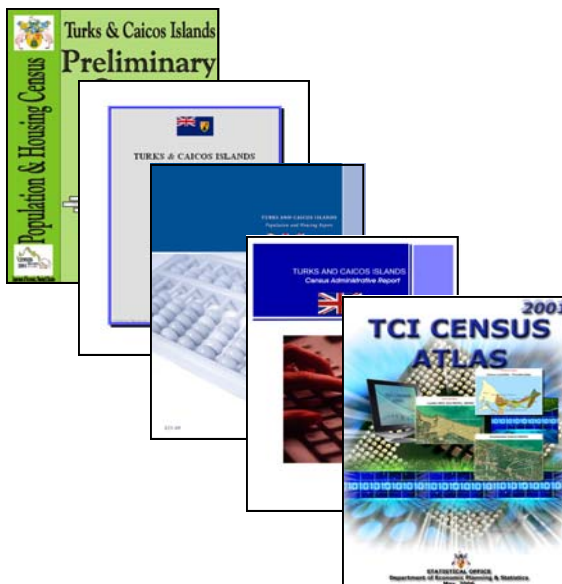

## About the Atlas...

The **TCI Census Atlas** is the final publication in the 2001 Population and Housing Census series prepared and released by the Statistical Office of the Department of Economic Planning and Statistics. The Census Atlas was preceded by the Preliminary Census Report, Report on Census 2001 Post Enumeration Survey, Population and Housing Report, and the Census Administrative Report.

As the name suggests, this publication cartographically represent key socio-economic variables relating to the conditions present in the TCI as reported by the 2001 Population and Housing Census. A total of 105 maps are contained within this Atlas and portray the demographic characteristics of the inhabited Islands of Grand Turk, Salt Cay, South Caicos, Middle Caicos, North Caicos and Providenciales, by locality level; and the entire Turks and Caicos by Island level. Parrot Cay was excluded due to unavailability of digitized island map. The construction of geographic variables and generation of data fields of the Census were prepared using MS Access and SPSS (Statistical Package for Social Sciences). Maps were reproduced using ArcView V8.2.



## Role of Geographic Information System (GIS) to Census

- Use of GIS base to define census area boundaries allows seamless integration of census database with GIS database (usually at Enumeration District (ED) level, or lower where possible);
- Allows systematic approach to subsequent censuses;
- Allows build from smallest 'spatial' unit of aggregation (surveyed land parcel);
- Provides basis for assembly of complex demographic and household indicators—reporting in maps, charts, table etc.

## Census Area Boundaries
