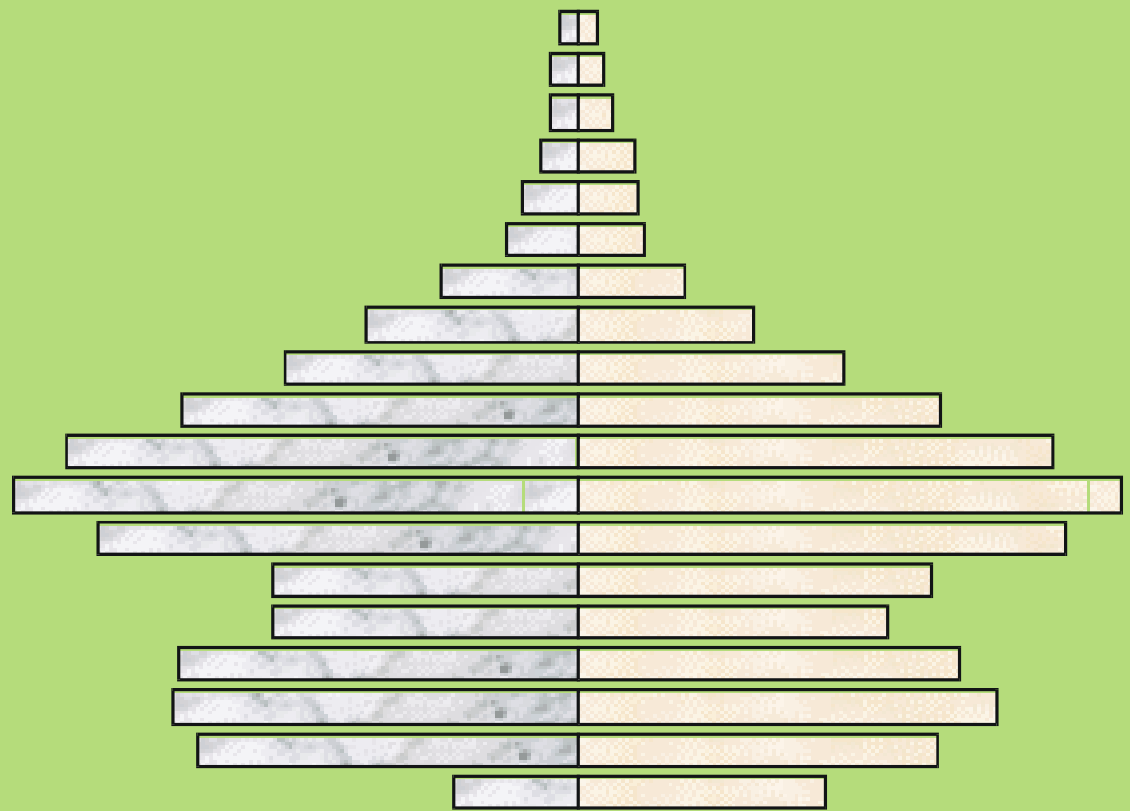

FOREWORD

INTRODUCTION

The Department of Economic Planning and Statistics (DEPS) is pleased to release the first set of results of the 2001 Population and Housing Census for the Turks and Caicos Islands and expects to publish more results in the coming months.

The 2001 Population and Housing Census was undertaken as part of the Year 2000 Round of Population and Housing Censuses. The Turks and Caicos Islands is a member of the Regional Census Coordinating Committee. Through this mechanism, participating countries have agreed to collaborate with regard to census methodology and procedures and the type of tables and statistics to be disseminated.

CENSUS ORDER/CENSUS DAY

The Census Order for the conduct of the 2001 Census of Population and Housing was made by Governor Jones on March 2001 in accordance with the Census Ordinance Chapter 174 of the revised laws of the Turks and Caicos Islands 1998. The Statistical Office started pre-census planning one year earlier in 2000. However, following the publication of the Census Order, the Census Office was established and the Controller of Census was appointed.

Census Enumeration commenced on August 20th 2001 and continued throughout all of the islands for a period of two months. Census Day was 10th September, 2001. This is the reference point for which all the statistics provided by members of private households and institutions in response to questions contained in the Census Questionnaires relate.

CENSUS AREAS

In order to execute the Census Enumeration the eight (8) inhabited islands were subdivided into 42 Localities. Each of the Localities was further subdivided into Statistical Areas called Enumeration Districts or EDs, which comprised approximately 125 – 150 households. 60 Enumerators canvassed the 79 Enumeration Districts, visiting and listing all Buildings in the Enumeration District, in the Record of Visits Logbook (VR). Simultaneously, Building numbers, recorded in the VR were also entered on state of the art digitized Maps of the EDs. This information will be used along with the Census information collected on the households to develop a Geographic Information System, (GIS).

THE CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRE

The Census Questionnaire contained approximately 100 questions, organized in 13 sections. Trained Enumerators visited each building in the ED and proceeded to conduct interviews with the Head of the Household or other respondent above the age of 15 years.

Each Questionnaire recorded the names of persons who were members of the household, identified the Head of household and the relationship of the other members of the Household to the Head of the household.

The Sections pertaining to Location on Census Night, Emigration and Mortality, Housing and Household Items, sections 11, 12 and 13 respectively, were designed to be answered by the Head of the Household for the entire household. Sections pertaining to Characteristics of the Household, Disability, Health and Nutrition, and Crime, sections 1,7 and 10 respectively were directed to all members of the household. The Fertility, section 6 was designed for completion by Females 15 – 49 years of age, only. The sections on Marital Status/ Union Status, Economic Activity, Transportation and Travel and

Income, sections 3, 5, 8, and 9 respectively were directed to those members of the household who were 15 years and over.

PROCESSING OF DATA

The Bureau of the Census assisted with the processing of the Statistical Tables. Estimates were made for CLOSED Dwellings, where the household was temporarily away at the time of Enumeration. Estimates were also made for those Households referred to as NO CONTACTS, where despite repeated visits, it was not possible to make contact with any responsible member of the household.

POST CENSUS RE-INTERVIEW

In May 2002, a Post Enumeration Survey (PES) was conducted to re-list and re-interview a sample of Enumeration Districts and Households. The PES is an objective and independent exercise to assess the extent of under-reporting in the 2001 Census, as well as, for evaluating errors of response and for estimating the margin of error of the estimate of the Census Population. The Post Enumeration Survey (PES) is now complete and the results will soon be released.

The Department of Economic Planning and Statistics expresses sincere thanks and deepest appreciation to all persons who participated in the Census and cooperated with Enumerators.

We also wish to express our gratitude to all those persons too numerous to mention who have been associated in any way with the planning and conduct of the 2001 Population and Housing Census and its follow-up exercise the Post Enumeration Survey. Special mention is made of the Field Personnel, Enumerators, Field Editors and their Supervisors whose dedication and commitment to a very difficult exercise made the realization of the project objectives possible.

2001 POPULATION AND HOUSING CENSUS

KEY CONCEPTS AND DEFINITIONS

Population Census

A population census is the total process of collecting, evaluating analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining at a specified time, to all persons in a country.

Total Population

The Total Population may comprise either all usual residents of the country or all persons present in the country at the time of the Census. The total of all usual residents is generally referred to as the **de jure** population and the total of all persons present at the time of the Census as the **de facto** population. The **de jure** concept of the population was used in the case of the Turks and Caicos Islands.

$$\text{Total Population} = \text{Institutional Population} + \text{Non-Institutional Population}$$

The following population groups were included in the enumeration:

- i. Persons living in private dwellings throughout the eight (8) inhabited islands of the Turks and Caicos.
- ii. Persons living in non-private dwellings, group dwellings and institutions.
- iii. Persons studying abroad who are usual residents of the Turks and Caicos Islands.

Non-Institutional/ Household Population

The Non-Institutional or Household Population refers to the sum of persons living in Private Dwellings in the Turks and Caicos Islands.

Institutional Population

The Institutional Population refers to All Persons living in non-private dwellings, Group dwellings and Institutions in the Turks and Caicos Islands. An institution is defined as living quarters where the occupants live collectively for such purposes as education, health, religion, military, discipline etc. The Institutional Population in the Turks and Caicos Islands includes persons in Her Majesty's Prison, Patients in Hospital, persons in Geriatric Homes etc.

Resident Population

The Resident Population refers to All Persons who reside in the Turks and Caicos Islands regardless of their Legal/Immigration Status. The Resident Population is the sum of the Belonger Population and the Non-Belonger Population.

Census Day/Census Moment

The specified period to which the data collected during the period of enumeration relate is known as Census day. Midnight of Census day is known as the Census moment. For the 2001 Population and Housing Census, the Census moment was midnight September 10th, 2001

Statistical Areas Defined

- **Islands** – Refer to the inhabited islands and cays of the Turks and Caicos Islands namely, Grand Turk, Salt Cay, South Caicos, Middle Caicos, North Caicos, Providenciales, Parrot Cay, and Pine Cay.
- **Localities** – The Statistical Office divided each of the islands listed above into localities or communities. These are conveniently demarcated areas for statistical purposes and not official administrative divisions. As far as possible, natural boundaries were maintained.
- **Enumeration Districts** – The above described localities, were further subdivided into Enumeration Districts comprising approximately one hundred and twenty-five households. An Enumeration District is the smallest statistical area.

Enumeration District

An Enumeration District (E.D.) is defined as a statistical area comprising approximately one hundred and twenty-five (125) households. In order to facilitate the process of census data collection, the islands were divided into 42 Localities, which were further sub-divided into 79 Enumeration Districts. An Enumeration District is an Enumerator's workload. It allows the enumerator the opportunity to visit every household in the Turks and Caicos within a reasonable timeframe.

A Building

A building is any independent free-standing structure comprising one or more rooms or other spaces covered by a roof and usually enclosed within external walls or dividing walls that extend from the foundation to the roof.

Buildings are of various types depending on their use. They may be single purpose buildings accommodating either Private Dwellings Units, Commercial or Industrial Business Units or Institutions, or they may be multi-purpose and include combinations of building types, e.g. commercial/residential where a building may house a dwelling and store.

Dwelling Units

Dwelling units or living quarters are **structurally separate and independent places** of abode. A dwelling is considered *separate* if the occupants can isolate themselves from other persons for purposes of sleeping, preparing and sharing meals. A dwelling may be considered *independent* when there is direct access from the street or from a public or communal stairway, passage, corridor or lobby. Occupants should, therefore, have access to their living quarters without having to pass through any other dwelling unit.

Dwelling Units may be of three types:

i. *Occupied* Dwelling Unit.

Occupied Dwelling Units are living quarters occupied by households. Dwellings may be either Private Dwellings or Non-private Dwellings or Institutions

A dwelling unit may be

- A single house,
- A half of a duplex
- Each self contained living quarters in apartments, condominiums and parts of commercial buildings or boarding houses catering for less than six (6) persons.

ii. *Closed* Dwelling Unit

A *closed* dwelling unit is one that is occupied but at the time of enumeration, the occupants were away for less than six (6) months.

iii. *Vacant* Dwelling Unit

Living quarters intended for and fit for use as a dwelling unit but at the time of enumeration was found to be unoccupied

Households

The Household is the principal unit of consideration. The household is defined as one or more persons who occupy a dwelling, and is/are involved in some common arrangements, sleeping most nights of the week and sharing at least one daily meal

It is important to note that these persons may not all be related. A household therefore, is not necessarily a family but can comprise different families living together or may be a group of unrelated persons living together such as students sharing a dwelling unit.

Business Unit

A part of a building that is occupied by a commercial or industrial enterprise involved in the production of goods and/or services.

Head of Household

The *Head of household* is the person recognized by other members as the head and is usually the person who carries the main responsibilities of the household. This person can be male or female.

In the case of an institution the person who runs an institution, guesthouse or similar activity is considered the Head.

At the beginning of the interview, the Head is identified and all information on the Head is recorded in the first column of the Questionnaire.

Relationship to the Head

All members of the Household are classified according to their relationship to the Head.

The following relationships have been identified:

Head - the person identified as Head

Spouse of Head - husband/wife or common law partner of the Head

Child - child of Head or spouse.

Grandchild - grandchild of the Head or of the spouse of the Head

Parent/Parent in law - parent of the Head or of the spouse

Other relative - any other relationship not identified above e.g. cousin, nephew, niece

Non relative - bears no relation to the Head e.g. boarder, lodger, friend, guest

Visitation Record

The Visitation Record (VR) was designed to monitor field visits during the enumeration phase of the Census. This document is used to construct a register of all buildings, dwelling units, households, institutions and businesses.

Census Questionnaire

The instrument used by the enumerators to collect and record information provided by the respondent on the members of the household.

Respondent

This term refers to the person providing the information to the Census Enumerator, during the interview. The preferred respondent is the Head of Household but any member of the household 15 yrs and older who is capable and willing may be the respondent in the absence of the Head of Household.

Sections of the Questionnaire

The questions in the Questionnaire are arranged into 13 Sections.

- **Sections to Head of Household**

Specific questions related to Housing, Migration (Emigration), and Crime were designed to be answered by the Head of the household for the entire household.

- **Questions to specific target groups**

Sections on Economic Activity and Income were directed to persons (both sexes) 15 years and over.

Questions on Fertility were designed for response by women within the childbearing age range, which was established at 15 to 49 years of age.

Statistical Tables

The data reported in the Statistical tables in the Preliminary Report refer to The Resident Household Population living in Private Dwellings, which were enumerated during the Census.

An estimate has been made for persons who live in Private Dwellings which were temporarily Closed at the time of enumeration as well as for persons known to be living in households but for which No-Contact was made with a suitable respondent despite numerous field visits during the process of census enumeration.

Therefore, persons who live in the Turks and Caicos Islands but who could not be present or could not be contacted during the Census have not been left out of the estimate of the Total Population of the Turks and Caicos Islands.

Statistical Tables therefore report on the Resident Household Population living in Private Dwellings. Tables are not presently available on persons living in Institutions.

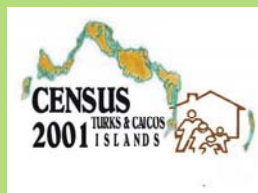

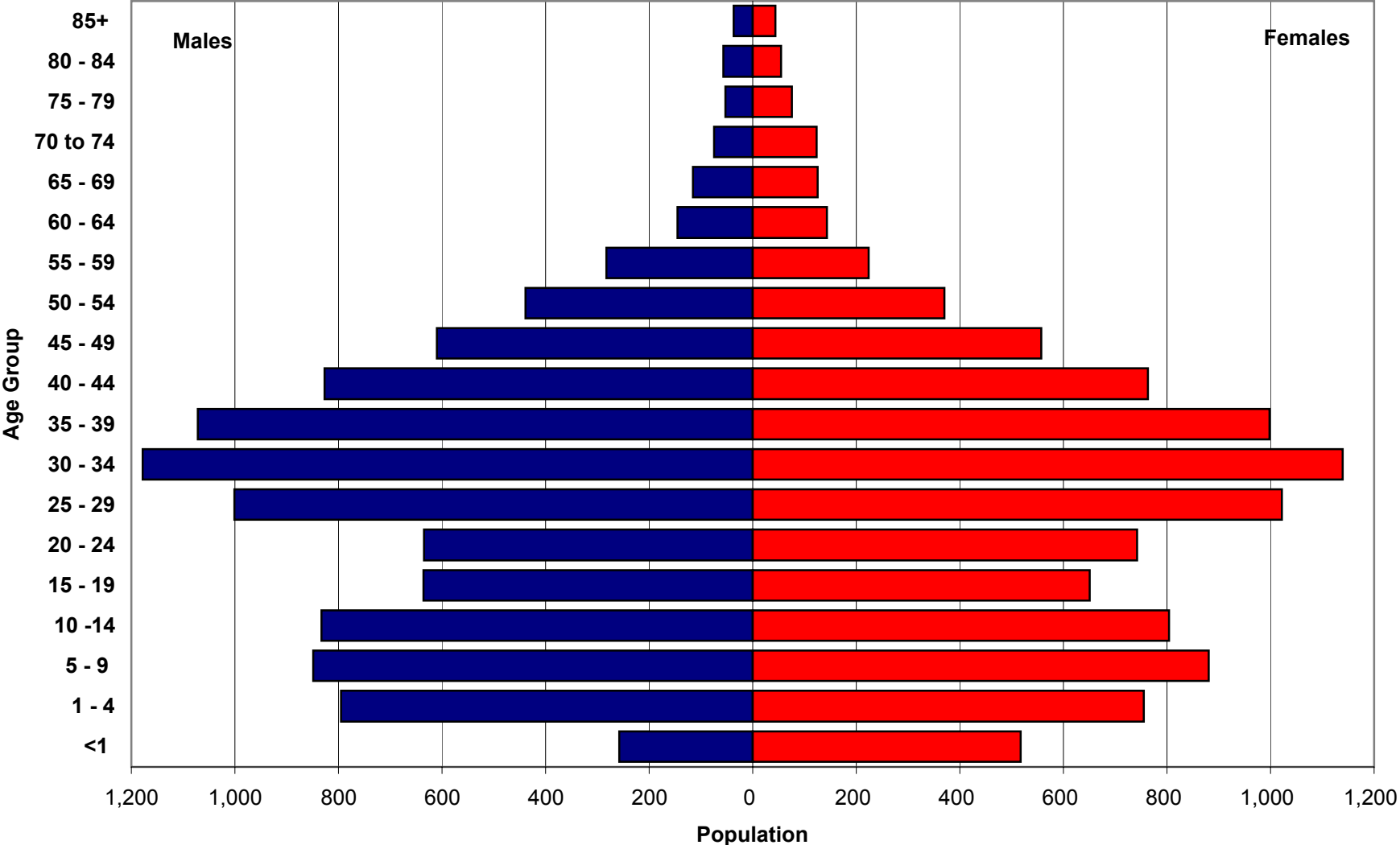

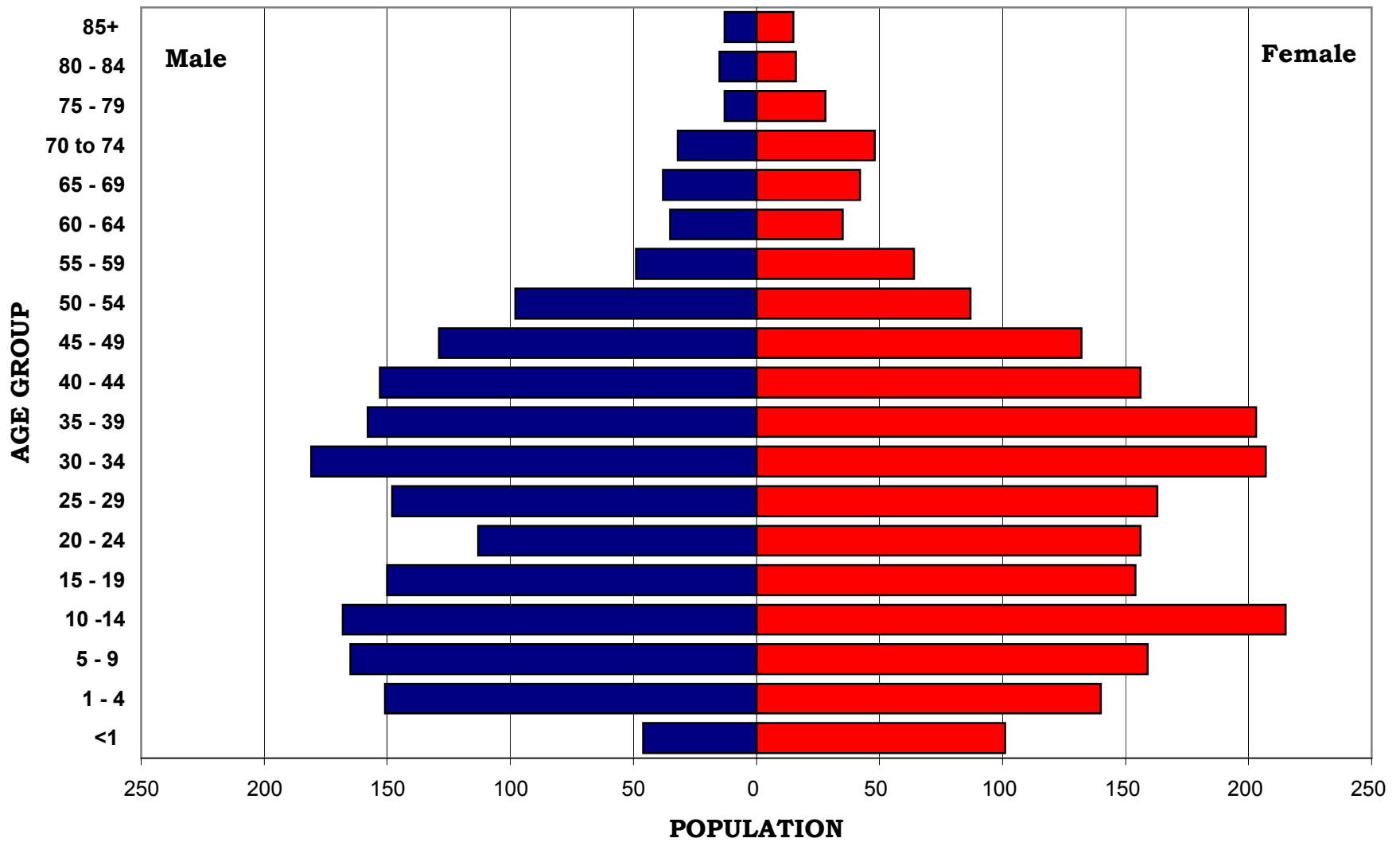

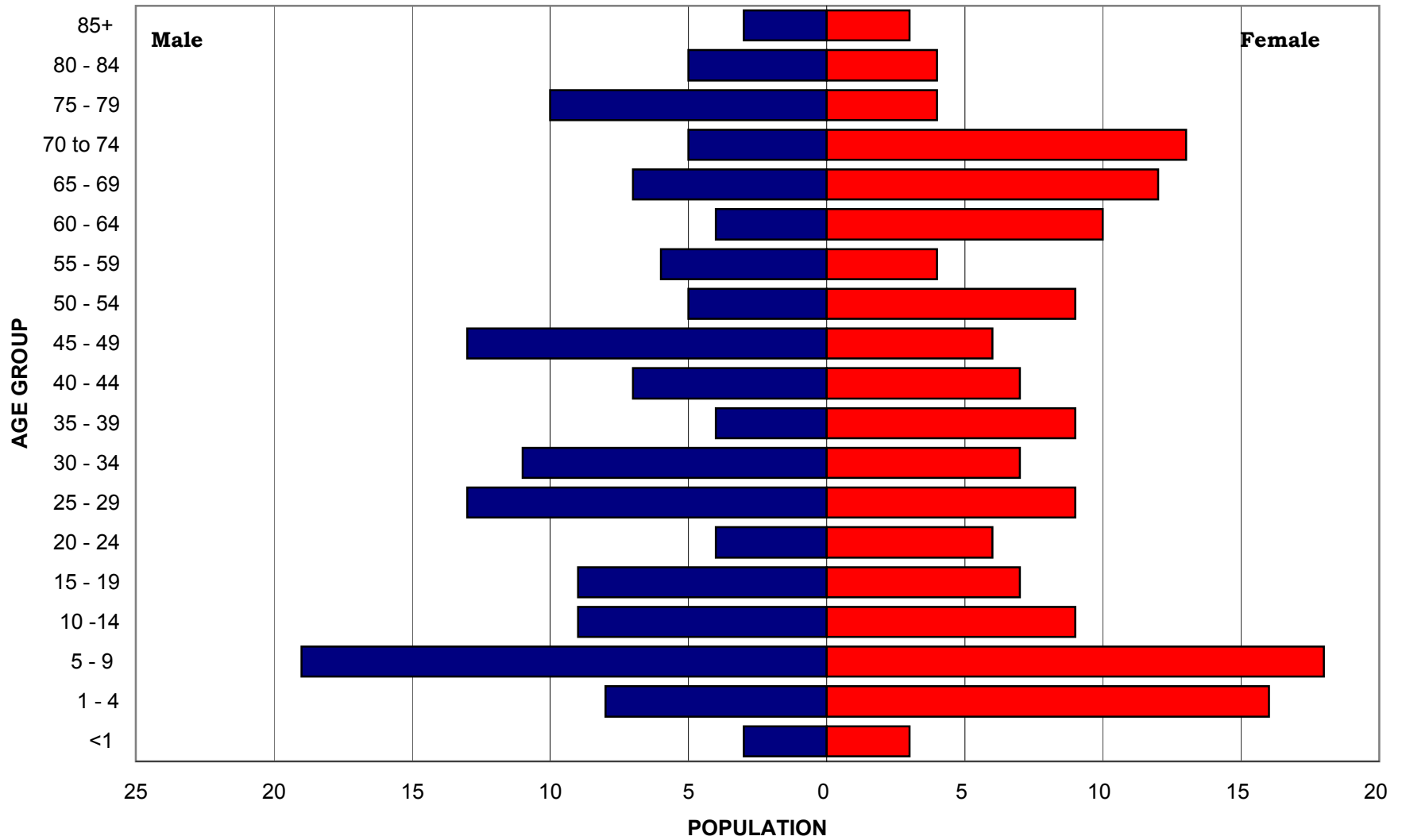
Population Pyramid: TCI, 2001



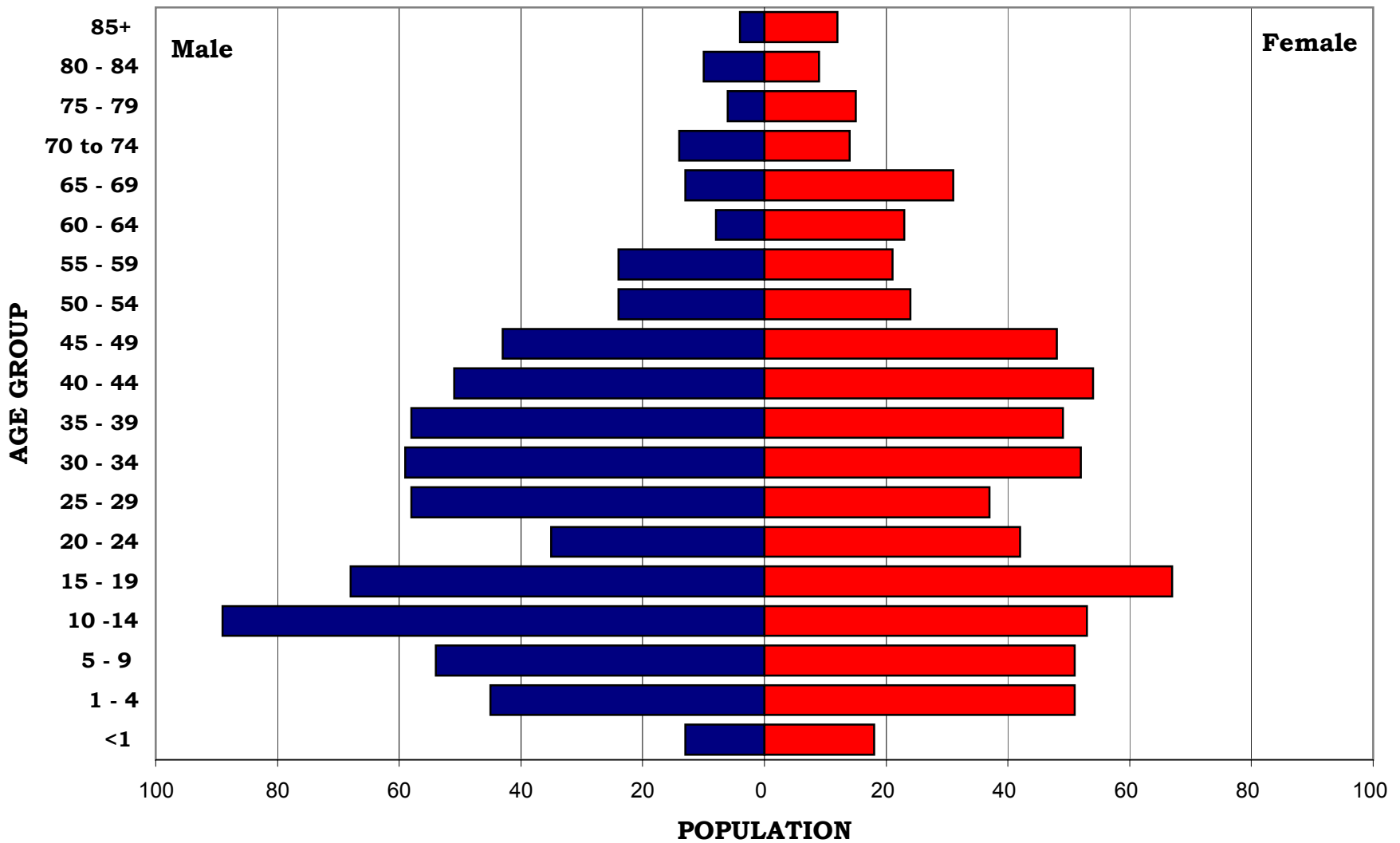
Population Pyramid: GRAND TURK, 2001



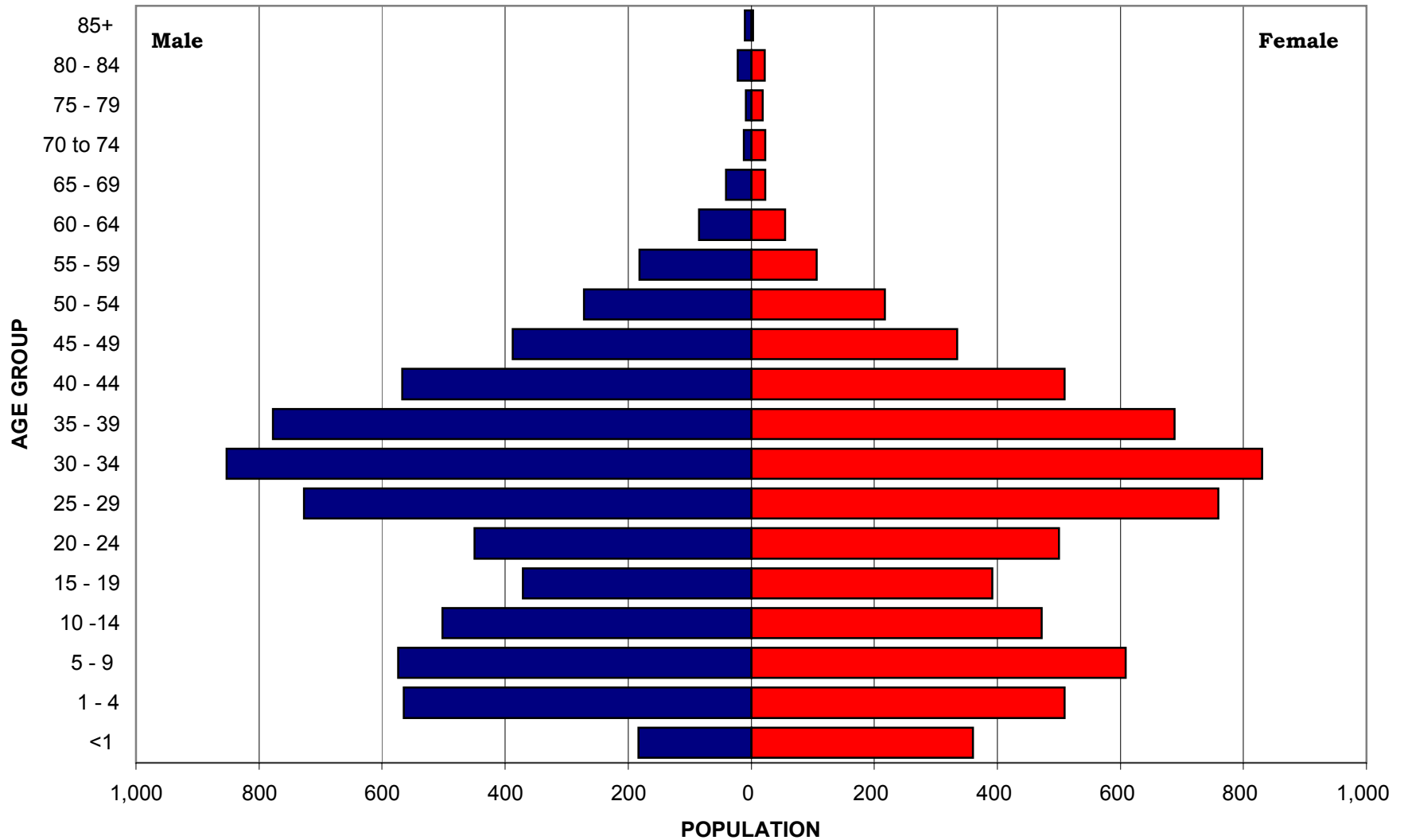
Population Pyrmad: MIDDLE CAICOS, 2001



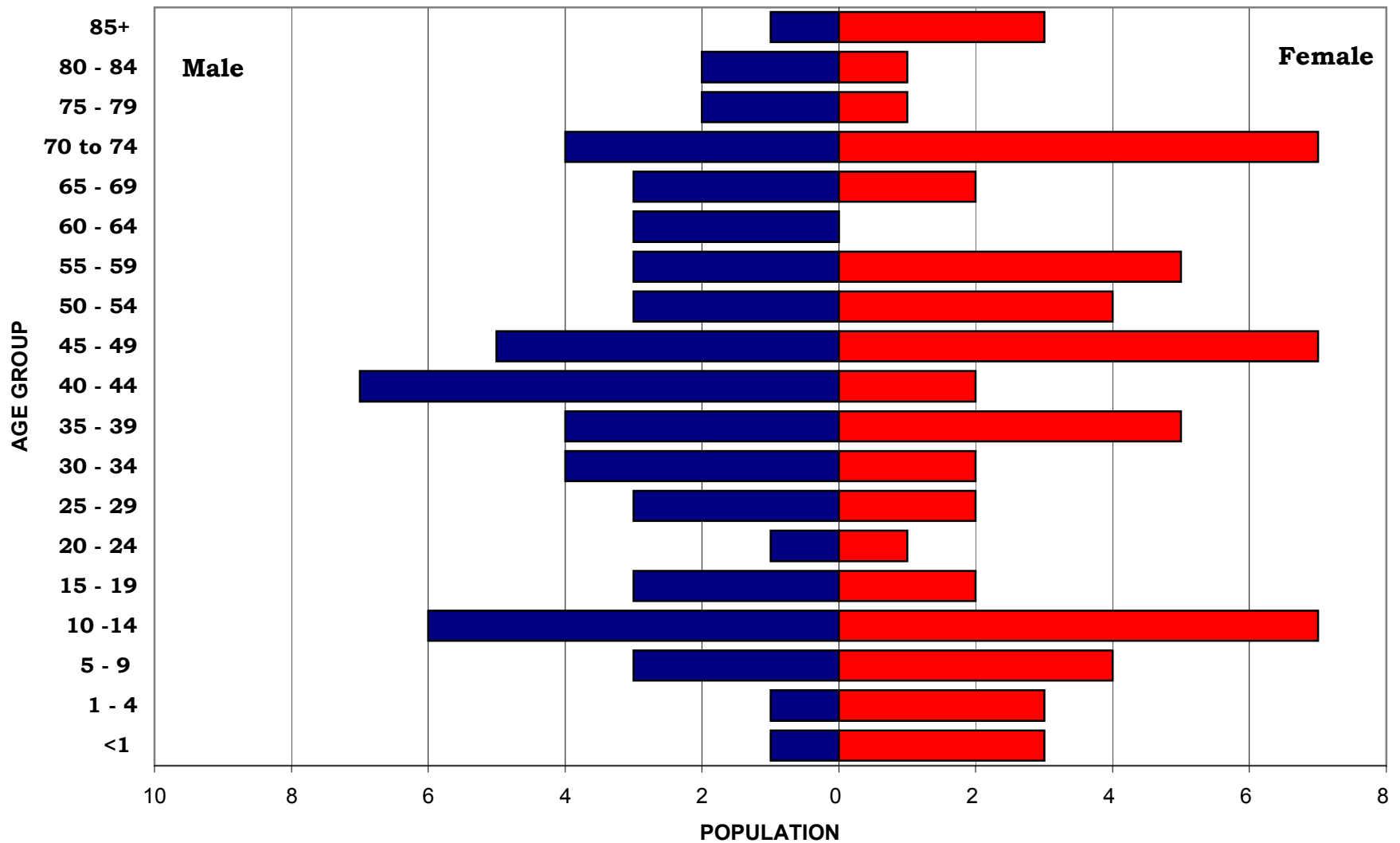
Population Pyrmid: NORTH CAICOS, 2001
